## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1. INVITATION

The Perth Dinghy Sailing Club (Inc) as Organising Authority, in conjunction with the Javelin Sailing Association of Western Australia, invite entries for the National Javelin Australian Championship.

### 2. RULES

- 2.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 2.2 The Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Yachting Australia shall apply.
- 2.3 Under rule 87, rule 5 of the Javelin Class Restrictions will apply.
- 2.4 Discretionary penalties will apply to Rule 41 – Outside Help. Actions of the Race Committee in retrieving crews from the water and returning them to their boats may not be penalised.

### 3. ADVERTISING

- 3.1 The ISAF advertising Code, Regulation 20 shall apply.
- 3.2 Boats may be required to display bow numbers and advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.
- 3.3 The organising authority reserves the right to refuse advertising by a boat or competitor when it is in conflict with an event sponsor or the laws of the Western Australian or Australian Governments.

### 4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The regatta is open to all Javelin Class boats and competitors who are members of Australian or New Zealand Javelin Association at the time of registration.
- 4.2 All Australian competitors are required to be members of YA and must provide proof of this membership, at registration. All competitors need to have a silver card and be a member of a yacht club.
- 4.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached Entry Form and sending it, together with the required fee, to WA Javelin Association by Friday 16<sup>th</sup> December 2011.
- 4.4 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organising authority until the start of the Invitation Race. A late entry fee will apply.
- 4.5 Boats will not be registered as a competitor until their entry fees are paid.

### 5. FEES

- 5.1 Required fees are as follows:  
 Regatta Entry Fee           \$260    (includes two tickets to Presentation night)  
 Late Entry Fee               \$80

7.2 Nine (9) Championship races are scheduled.

7.3 No warning signal shall be made after 1500 hours on Thursday, 5<sup>th</sup> January, 2012

7.4 No more than two (2) races will be sailed on any one day.

**8. MEASUREMENTS**

The following measurements will be taken:

    Weigh all hulls

    Measure all sails, spars and foils

Please allow 2 to 3 hours for this process.

**9. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions may be published on the Javelin website, [www.javelins.org](http://www.javelins.org), by Friday 16<sup>th</sup> December 2011. Copies will be available at registration.

**10. VENUE**

10.1 Attachment A shows the location of the Perth Dinghy Sailing Club.

10.2 Attachment B shows the location of the racing area - Melville Water East.

**11. THE COURSES**

11.1 Courses will be Windward-Leeward format

11.2 Course diagrams, showing the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.

11.3 The approximate race duration will be 90 minutes. When two races are held on one day, the approximate race duration time will be 50 minutes for each race.

**12. SCORING**

12.1 Four races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

- 12.2 (a) When fewer than six races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- (b) When from six to seven races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- (c) When eight or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.
- 12.3 A boat's handicap for the handicap series will be determined by an administrator appointed by the WA Javelin Sailing Association and will be adjusted as deemed fit by that administrator. Any disagreement with the set handicap will not be grounds for redress.

**13. RADIO COMMUNICATION**

While on the water, a boat shall not carry equipment capable of making radio transmissions or receiving radio transmissions except for equipment provided by the Organising Authority. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones

**14. PRIZES**

Prizes will be given as follows:

- "Australian National Javelin Championship Trophy" to the Overall Winner
- Second and Third overall.
- Handicap winner of the Invitation Race
- Handicap winner of each heat
- Womens skipper trophy
- Junior skipper trophy

**15. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESSES**

In participating in an event, a competitor automatically grants to the Organising Authority and the sponsors of the event, the right in perpetuity, to make, use and show, from time to time and at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or film television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition for the said event in which the competitor participates and in all material related to the said event without compensation.

**16. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, "Decision to Race". The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

**17. INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5,000,000 per event or equivalent. By signing the Entry Form, entrants are deemed to have made a declaration that they have such cover.

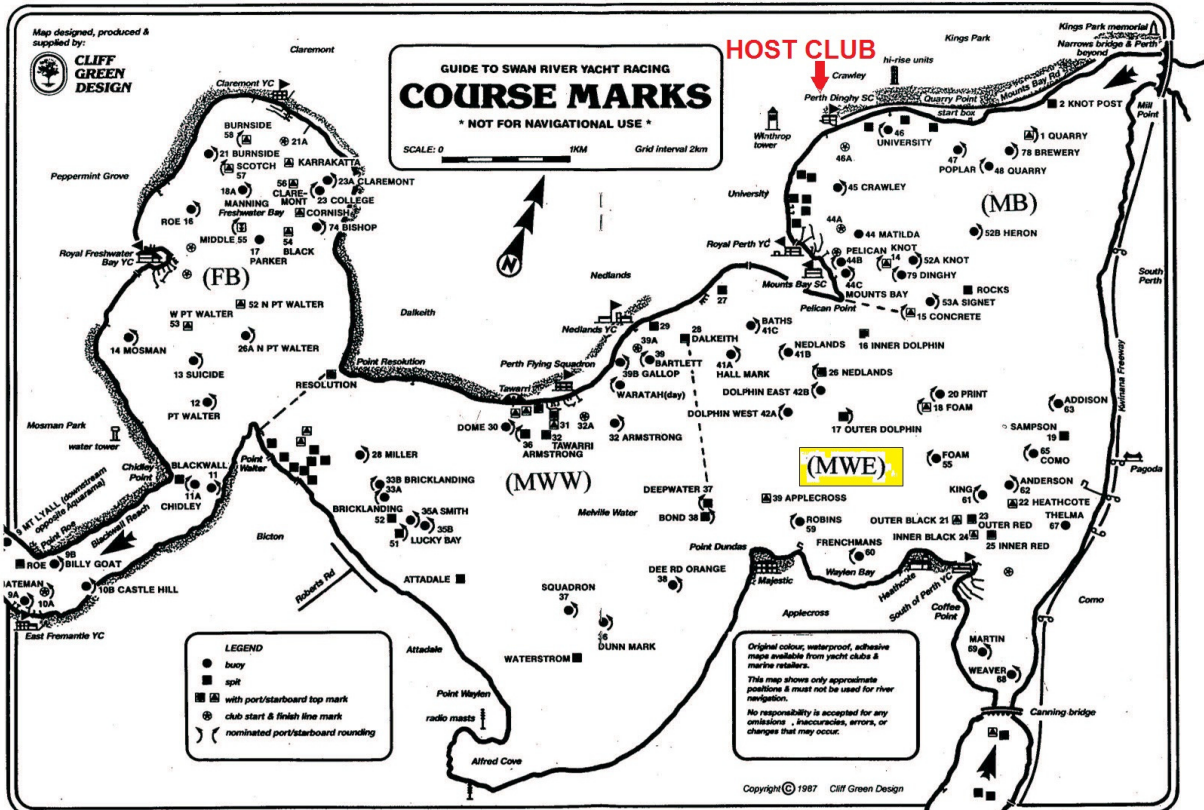
